- Outdoor activities












# Why not US

### **US Licensing System**

#### **USMLE**

Step 1 = basic science - clinically oriented

Step 2 CK = Clinical Knowledge

Step 2 CS = Clinical Skills

Step 3 = clinical judgement

#### Which Visa?

#### H1b/H4 Visa

**Pros** - No 2 year home requirement, fast green card process, can work anywhere, 3yr term

**Cons** - Competitive, H4 can't work, difficult to get fellowship that sponsor H visa

#### J1/J2 Visa

**Pros** – less competitive, J2 can work, Many fellowship welcome J1 visa

**Cons**- 2 year rule applies. Needs J1 waiver to start green card process, needs to be renewed every year.
